Principal's Update- Tom Ptacek

- Mr. Engle's leave officially ends on June 5
 - Mr. Engle is talking to Central Office about other options within the district.
 - There is no information about a principal about next year.
- Staffing for next year:
 - 4th grade will have four teachers next year
 - 2nd grade will have two teachers next year (great teachers!)
 - Class size will be 27
 - Some students may be leaving
 - Kindergarten has only 35 children currently enrolled
 - Do people assume that they don't need to enroll early because there is only a full day option?
 - Expect this number to grow
 - Sanford and Towle will job share next year
- Additional staff is specialists also included
- Academic funding is 1.5 (formerly known as equity staffing); could possibly be used for second grade if test scores are low enough
- Overall, all class sizes are low across the board
- Barb Evens has been a good support for the school, including observations and interacting with parents
- Several new job postings have been placed
- District gave us several new staff because the district recognizes that this school needs some additional support
